The city of Šiauliai in facts and figures



- Šiauliai is the 4th largest city in Lithuania;
- Population of 110 thousand (as of January, 2024);
- # Historically has been an industrial hub of the country;
- Great geographical location great accessibility;
- Labour pool of over 57 thousand;
- Two special economic zones (one is almost fully packed already).



Revival of the city of the Sun



- Lowest unemployment rate among the major cities of the country (7,5%);
- Positive migration balance since 2018 both in the city and in the region, fastest-growing city in Lithuania for two consecutive years;
- Second-fastest FDI growth among all regions of Lithuania since 2018;
- Since 2013 the average wage has more than tripled in the city of Šiauliai (gross monthly wage as of the fourth quarter of 2023: 1 814 Eur.).

In September, 2023 the number of first-year students at the Siauliai city higher education institutions and the vocational center has increased by over 35% with around 2750 new first-year students enrolled.






Šiauliai – the city that has re-emerged in recent years



- The budget of the city of Šiauliai has more than tripled in the last 9 years:
- Budget in 2015: 82.28 million Euros;
- **Budget** in 2023 (the end of the financial year): 256.8 million Euros.

Šiauliai has become increasingly attractive for foreign investors



- Foreign direct investment in the city of Šiauliai increased more than four times between 2015 and 2022 and has continued to grow since.
- Foreign direct investment in 2022 (most recent statistics):

1st Netherlands: 62.7 million euros 2nd Sweden: 36.2 million euros 3rd Germany: 33.4 million euros

Foreign direct investment in the city of Šiauliai (in millions of Euros)








Development of the Šiauliai Free Economic Zone – from a forest in 2015 to an industrial centre of the region by 2020










Šiauliai Free Economic Zone offers:
